Recent Events Around the Village

Over the past several months we've accomplished a number of things around the complex, including:

- Repairing damaged concrete walks, steps and curbs
- Repairing four failed skylights
- Installing bicycle hooks in the north garbage shed and bicycle racks in the south garbage shed
- Purchasing a new microwave oven for the clubhouse
- Contracting for installation of heat cable in front gutters at homeowners' choice to mitigate ice and icicles
- Replenishing the supply of snow melt in all three garbage sheds for use by homeowners during the winter
- Contracting for snow removal for the season
- Cleaning all the gutters in the complex
- Cleaning the carpet in the clubhouse
- Installing privacy slats in the chain link fence along Hubbard Street and Lincoln Way – a big "Thank You!" to all seven residents who helped with the installation
- Installing reflective snow markers along our curbs to prevent them from being damaged by snow plows
- Establishing a committee of homeowners to advise the board on long-range funding of major projects.

Winter Tips

The start of winter is a good time to have a wood-burning chimney cleaned to prevent chimney fires.

If you have fire extinguishers, It is recommended that you have them serviced once a year.

Please remove all hoses so the water line will not freeze.

If you leave for more than 2 or 3 days:

- Turn off the main water valve to your unit
- Set your furnace to at least 60 degrees
- Give the managers a contact number for an emergency, and if you wish, also a key.
